

Trekking Kyrgyzstan

Seven Bulls Trek

ID	KL-AA-3	Days	3

This five days-long trek takes in the colorful and picturesque valleys located in the Eastern Kyrgyzstan. You will have a great chance to see the world's second largest alpine lake Issyk-Kul, mountain ranges and snow capped peaks, passes, hot springs of Altyn-Arashan valley and truly amazing Ala-Kul lake located high in the mountains at the altitude of 3500 metres above sea level. The tour begins and ends with the opportunity to visit some of Kyrgyzstan's finest cultural and historical treasures.

The route begins with drive to Karakol town located on the eastern shore of Issyk-Kul lake. There will be time to swim and explore the lake and its environs on foot or by boat before continue to Karakol, once a Russian fortress. Next day we will drive up into the nearby Karakol valley. Here, porters take over and carry personal luggage and camping gear for the trek through stunning mountain scenery. The trekking route, known as the 'Karakol to Altyn-Arashan', goes through cool juniper groves and passes crystal clear Ala-Kol lake, many tempestuous rivers, high glaciated summits and a wide variety of colorful panoramas with breathtaking landscapes. The alpine meadows are extremely beautiful with a profusion of flowers and lush grass pastures. Several Golden Eagles have their home here along with other colorful bird and wild-life. There will be time at the end of the trek for sightseeing and shopping in Karakol's and Bishkek's bazaars, and we will gather together for a banquet on the final night.

Grade

The tour is two days trekking on foot. Paths are generally in good shapes. Mountain passes are steep but not technically difficult. The trek is porter-assisted, so you need to carry only a day pack with some of your belongings. Average walking time is around 5-6 hours per day. Daily altitude gain is about 500-800 m. You must be reasonably fit to attempt this trek. Trekking/hiking and camping background advisable but not essential.

Trek Crew

The trek is assisted by guide, cook and porters who carry camping gear for the trek.



1 Day

Karakol - Jety Oguz valley

Breakfast. Meet crew and drive 40 km to picturesque Djety Oguz valley by exciting mountain road winding through fir tree forest and between stunning rocks along rushing waters of Djety Oguz river. Next stage is trek up the Telety valley through the forest. Lunch on the bank of the mountain river. After lunch continue trek up along the valley floor to Telety pass foothills. Dinner. Overnight in tents.

2 Day

Jety Oguz valley - Karakol valley

Breakfast. Trek over Telety pass (3800 m) with a fascinating view of highest peaks of Terskey Ala-Too. Lunch upon descent from the pass. Trek down to Karakol valley trough fur tree forest. It is a nice wooded canyon ending with a gorgeous peak Karakol (5218 m). Dinner around fire. Overnight in tents near the Karakol river.



Karakol valley - Karakol - Bishkek

Breakfast. Hike to the upper grounds of Karakol valley to see the gorgeous Karakol peak of 5218 metres above sea level with small alpine lake in the foot hills. Return back to camp. Lunch. PM Short trek down the road and meet vehicle. Drive to Karakol town by very spectacular mountain road. Accommodation in guest house. Free time to explore Karakol's environs. Dinner. Overnight in guest house.
